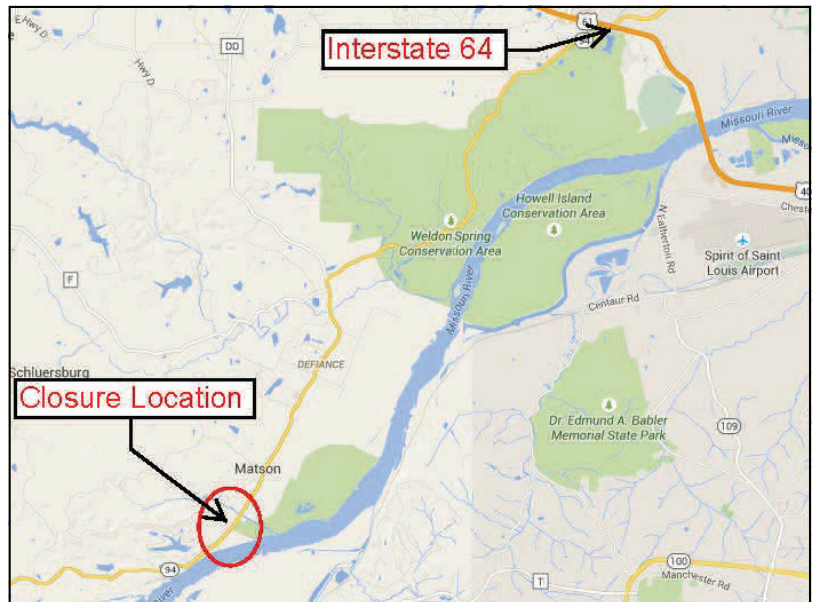
Expect Summer Impacts on Route 94

Motorists heading to some of the wineries this summer need to be aware of a significant traffic impact on Route 94. MoDOT will close Route 94 between Terry Road and Schluersburg Road starting in mid-June.

The work will raise the height of the road just west of Terry Road by more than three feet. This will help prevent frequent flooding in the area from the Missouri River. This stretch of Route 94 is often

the first section that goes under water when the river rises, cutting off access to the road, homes and businesses in the area.

Drivers can detour around the closure by taking Route F and Schluersburg Road. The road will remain closed until mid-August.

This is the first half of a larger Route 94 project, which will also add shoulders, make curve corrections and repave Route 94 from Route 47 to Route D.
