Route 364/Page Phase 3 is Regional AASHTO Winner

The Route 364/Page Phase 3 project recently won a regional award in the America's Transportation Awards competition. The project was honored in the "Quality of Life/Community Development" category for reducing congestion on I-64 and I-70 and for reducing the commute times of local residents by as much as 15 minutes.

The awards are given annually in four regional competitions to recognize America's best transportation projects. The ten regional winners with the highest overall scores will
