Public Hearing Scheduled for Upcoming Route 61 Project

A major construction project on Route 61 in Wentzville will get underway in the summer of 2017, but residents can get a sneak peak at plans during MoDOT's public hearing on November 12. The project will make changes to the interchange of Route 61 and Route P, as well as make safety improvements on Route 61 between Route A and Peine Road. The meeting is a chance for property owners and other interested parties to learn about the impacts and discuss construction plans with project engineers.

The open house-style public meeting will be held from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Thursday, November 12 at St. Theodore School, located at 5059 Highway P in Wentzville.

Westbound I-64 Traffic to be Moved to 1980s Boone Bridge

Traffic will soon be flowing westbound across the 1980s Boone Bridge. In the next few weeks, crews will be shifting traffic off the narrow, 1930s bridge and onto the old eastbound bridge. Only three lanes will be open initially, but the fourth lane is expected to be open by the end of the year.

The newly constructed eastbound Boone Bridge opened to traffic over the summer, which allowed crews to close the 1980s bridge and make renovations to it. The old 1930s bridge will be demolished in early 2016. In addition, the bike-ped path on the new eastbound bridge will be open for use in the spring of 2016.

- 16 winter events totaling 16.8 inches
- 24,500 tons of salt used
- 114,000 gallons of beet juice used
- 12,800 pounds of calcium chloride
- 93,945 hours worked
