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Safety Project to Make Improvements in St. Charles County

Over the last 10 years, 8,752 Missourians have died in car crashes. They, along with the other 30,000 motorists who die on the road every year, are the faces of a troubling statistic. MoDOT's newest design-build project takes direct aim at that statistic.

This one-of-a-kind project will improve safety around St. Charles County by tapping into public and private industries to find innovative strategies to reduce crashes and save lives.

The St. Louis District Safety Design-Build project will

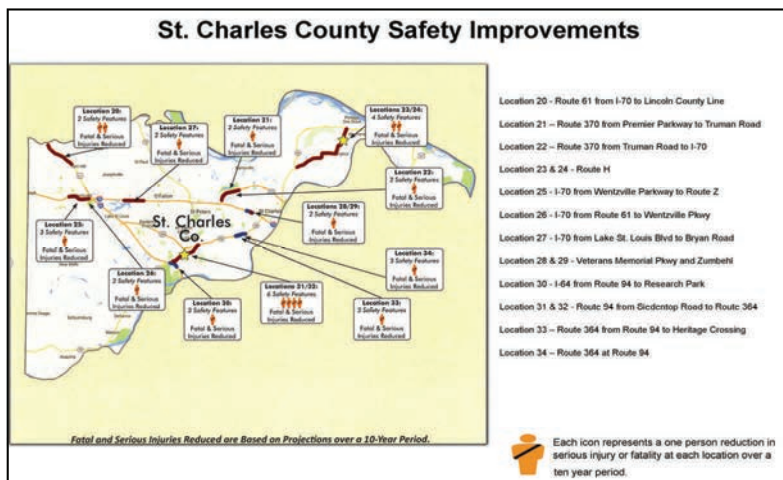
make safety improvements at more than 30 locations in Franklin and St. Charles Counties. Among the improvements being made in St. Charles are:

- Guardcable on Route 61 from I-70 to the Lincoln County line
- Center and edgeline rumble strips on Route H
- Right turn angle improvements on Route 94 at Weldon Springs Road and Wolfrum Road.
- LED stop signs at Route 94 and South Breeze Road
- High friction surface treatments on various routes around the county

Over 10 years, the improvements are expected to reduce the number of fatal and serious injury crashes by more than 70 people.

Work on the project got underway earlier this month and is expected to be completed by the winter of 2018.
