Construction, Construction Everywhere

If you drive around St. Charles County these days you'll see a lot of our crews out and about. Spring is (finally) here and that means we are out patching potholes, striping the roads and making repairs.

In addition, construction projects are in full swing around the region. Below is an update on some of the bigger projects in the area.

- **Route 61 at Route P/Peine Road** - Work continues on the new

interchange with girders for the new bridge going up this week. Next week is our first major closure when Route P closes at Route 61 on May 1 for about three months. Drivers can take Grothe Road to get to Route P. For more information or to sign up for e-updates, go to http://www.modot.org/stlouis/major_projects/Route61SafetyProject.htm.

- **St. Louis District Safety Design Build project** - Design work is done and crews have completed work at 11 of the 31 locations. Guardcable work along Route 61 will be wrapping up soon with the exception of a section around the Route P/Peine Road project which will be installed before the end of that project. - **I-64 at I-70/Route 61** - The ramp from westbound I-70 to southbound Route 61/eastbound I-64 remains closed as part of a project to make pavement improvements at the interchange. The ramp will remain closed for about another month.

In addition, more projects will be getting underway soon:

- **Route 364 at Mid Rivers Mall Drive** - Work begins this summer to add an additional lane on westbound Route 364 before Mid Rivers Mall Drive. Changes will also be made on eastbound Route 364.
- **Interstate 70 from Fifth Street to Fee Fee Road** - Pavement rehab and resurfacing work will begin in May.
- **Route N at Sam's Creek** - The bridge will be replaced this summer. This will require a full closure of Route N once school is out for the year.
