Dear Mr. Rahn:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have reviewed Missouri Department of Transportation's (MoDOT) request to incorporate the East West Gateway Coordinating Council's (EWGCC) modification of their FY 2009-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as further described in your letter of April 1, 2009, as an amendment to the FY 2009-2013 Missouri Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The modifications to be amended into the STIP include the addition of three new Metro transit projects and 52 new local public agency sponsored highway projects. All of the new transit and highway projects are being funded with American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) funding. Twenty of the 52 highway projects are located within an economically distressed area (EDA).

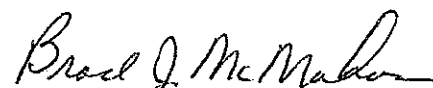
The EWGCC Board approved this TIP amendment on February 25, 2009. The Missouri Governor approved the EWGCC's amendment on March 31, 2009.

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.218(b), we have determined that this STIP amendment is based on a transportation planning process that substantially meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304 and 23 CFR 450 Subparts A, B, and C. Based on our review, this STIP amendment request is approved.

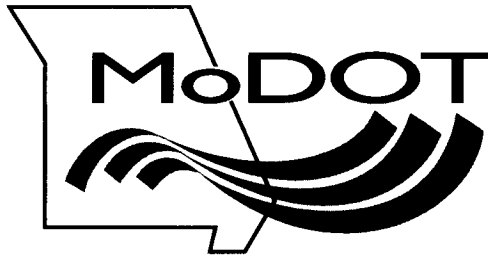
