Dear Mr. Rahn:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has reviewed the Missouri Department of Transportation's (MoDOT) request to incorporate the Columbia Area Transportation Organization (CATSO) modification of their FY 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as further described in your letter of December 7, 2009, as an amendment to the FY 2010-2014 Missouri Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The modification to be amended into the STIP involves the addition of four new MoDOT highway projects. All four of the thin lift resurfacing projects will be financed with American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) funding. None of the new projects are located within an economically distressed area (EDA).

The CATSO Coordinating Committee approved the TIP amendments on November 13, 2009. The Missouri Governor approved the CATSO amendments on December 4, 2009.

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.218(b), we have determined that this STIP amendment is based on a transportation planning process that substantially meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304 and 23 CFR 450 Subparts A, B, and C. Based on our review, this STIP amendment request is approved.
