The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has reviewed the Missouri Department of Transportation's (MoDOT) request to incorporate the Mid-America Regional Council's (MARC) modification of their FY 2010-2014 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as further described in your letter of June 8, 2010, as an amendment to the FY 2010-2014 Missouri Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The modification includes the addition of two City of Kansas City sponsored highway projects that are being funded with American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) funding. Both of these projects are located within an economically distressed area (EDA).

The MARC Board of Directors approved the TIP amendments on April 27, 2010. The Missouri Governor approved the MARC amendments on June 7, 2010.

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.218(b), we have determined that this STIP amendment is based on a transportation planning process that substantially meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304 and 23 CFR 450 Subparts A, B, and C. Based on our review, this STIP amendment request is approved.
