The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has reviewed the Missouri Department of Transportation's (MoDOT) request to incorporate the addition of one MoDOT project and to St. Joseph Area Transportation Study Organization's (SJATSO) FY 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as further described in your letter of December 16, 2009, as an amendment to the FY 2010-2014 Missouri Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The aforementioned project is utilizing \$458,000 in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds. The SJATSO Coordinating Committee approved the TIP amendment on December 10, 2009.

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.218(b), we have determined that this STIP amendment is based on a transportation planning process that meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C. 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304, and 23 CFR 450 Subparts A, B, and C. Based upon MoDOT's and the local jurisdiction's commitments found in the supplemental documentation to this action, the STIP amendment request is approved.
